Suitable and sufficient resource, supervision, education and ongoing training are provided for all employees.

It is also the company's objective to offer support, guidance and information to our sub-contractors and supply chain to help them achieve the standards the company sets itself.

This policy will be issued to all employees and other interested parties and will be reviewed annually to ensure compliance with legislation and relevance to the company's activities.
